




### Licensed Drivers and Drivers Involved in Fatal and Personal Injury Crashes by Age Group









By Agency Type**


**All Tickets**




**Seat Belt Tickets**



**Speed Tickets**




**Persons Ticketed for Impaired Driving**



By Agency Type**




